B'not Mitzvah Together objectives and values

The B'not Mitzvah Together program is a 7-month journey designed for incoming 6thgrade girls. Throughout this period, they delve into the role of women in Judaism while uncovering the beauty of our rituals and traditions through a series of weekly sessions, both onsite and off campus. Every session is dedicated to deepen into one or more Jewish value. The ultimate goal is to prepare these girls to become the Jewish women of tomorrow.

Sessions will be held on Thursday afternoons, starting at 5:00 PM, with some additional sessions on Sundays. An annual calendar will be provided prior to the kickoff event.

Each session is documented, and the girls compile a scrapbook to preserve their memories of this journey.

Our program is led predominantly by our professional staff and clergy, each session is hands-on, occasionally featuring guest professionals from various fields.

The program also includes a trip to New York, where the girls will explore Jewish immigration history of the 1900s in comparison to their family's immigration stories.
